

## Selection Criteria for the AGIC Infrastructure Sustainability Rating Tool Pilot Trials

The following outlines the Selection Criteria which will be used by the AGIC Selection Team to select projects for round 2 of the AGIC Infrastructure Sustainability Rating Tool Pilot Trials (in no particular order):

- Infrastructure types covered by the AGIC scheme
- Nomination by an AGIC Member organisation, where the nominating member organisation is a significant or influential stakeholder in the project (preference given to suitable projects nominated by Foundation Members)
- Project must be in the construction or operation phase (i.e. have completed the design phase and/or completed the construction phase)
- Projects selected for Round 2 of the trial will be at various locations across Australia
- Project size (substantive capital and/or annual operating cost)
- Demonstrative application of sustainability principles across the AGIC categories
- Awards
- History of involvement with AGIC
- Other criteria as decided by the AGIC Selection Team
